Conference Theme

The Legacy of Mwalimu Nyerere in Leadership and Socio-Economic Development in a New Era of Industrialisation.

Sub-themes

- 1) Education for self-reliance as an engine for socio-economic development Presentations may include the following issues: practical skills development; critical thinking and problem solving; sustainable development and environmental awareness; entrepreneurship and business skills; cultural preservation and heritage; financial literacy and money management; health and well-being; digital literacy and technological skills; civic engagement and social responsibility; and lifelong learning and continuous improvement.
- 2) Industrialisation and economic self-reliance in national development Presentations may include the following issues: infrastructure development; investment and financing; technological innovation and research; human resource development; supply chain development; sustainable industrialization; market development; policy and regulatory framework; industrial cluster development; and small and medium enterprises (SME) support.
- 3) Unity and national building in human, states and regional development Presentations may include the following issues: shared values and identity; social cohesion and inclusion; intercultural and interreligious harmony; peacebuilding and conflict resolution; democratic governance and good leadership; shared institutions and governance systems; economic integration and cooperation; education and awareness; sports, arts, and culture; and cross-border cooperation and regional integration.

4) Leadership and good governance for accelerates socio-economic development. Presentations may include the following issues: vision and goal setting; effective communication; decision-making and problem-solving; emotional intelligence and relationship building; integrity and ethical leadership; adaptability and resilience; empowering and developing others; collaboration and team building; strategic thinking and innovation; and resonant leadership.

Conference Venue: The conference is planned as a face-to-face event to be held at the Mwalimu Nyerere Memorial Academy – Kivukoni Campus, Dar es Salaam.

Modes of presentation: Both oral and poster presentations will be accepted. During submission of your abstract please specify the preferred mode of your presentation.
