A. FROM SENIOR LECTURER TO ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR POSITION

1. <u>Dr. Evaristo Mwasigwavingi Haulle</u>, Deputy Rector of Planning, Finance and Administration.



Dr. Evaristo M. Haulle is a Senior Lecturer in Geography with extensive expertise in disaster risk reduction, rural livelihoods and resource governance and traditional environmental knowledge systems. **Dr. Haulle** is the author of one book and editor of four others. He has also published numerous journal articles. He holds a PhD in Geography, a Master of Arts in Geography and Environmental Management and a Bachelor of Arts in Geography and Environmental Studies from the University of Dar es Salaam. He also holds a Bachelor of Laws (LLB) from the Open University of Tanzania. Since his last promotion to the Senior Lecturer position in 2020 he has published 18 academic articles in international journals.

Dr. Haulle has been promoted to an **Associate Professor** position after earning a total of 8.9 points, where 7.9 points are from publications in international journals and 1 point from teaching.

In addition to his academic career, He has served as Head of Department of Geography, Dean of Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences and Deputy Principal - Academic Research and Consultancy at Mkwawa University College of Education.

B. FROM LECTURER TO SENIOR LECTURER POSITION

1. <u>Dr. Njana Tegisi Masanja</u>, <u>Department of Language and Literature</u>, Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences.



Dr. Njana T. Masanja is a lecturer in Kiswahili Linguistics. He has a long experience in teaching and research in the field of Kiswahili Linguistics, especially in Phonology, Morphology, Syntax, Sociolinguistics, Semantics, and Lexicography. Since his promotion to the Lecturer position in June 2021, he has published six research articles in local and international journals. Dr. Njana has been promoted to **Senior Lecturer** after earning a total of 6.5 points, with 5.5 points from publications in local and international journals and 1 point from teaching.

2. <u>Dr. Angela Mathias Kavishe</u>, <u>Department of Social Studies</u>, Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences



Dr. Angela M. Kavishe is a lecturer in social studies specializing in sociology and gender issues.
